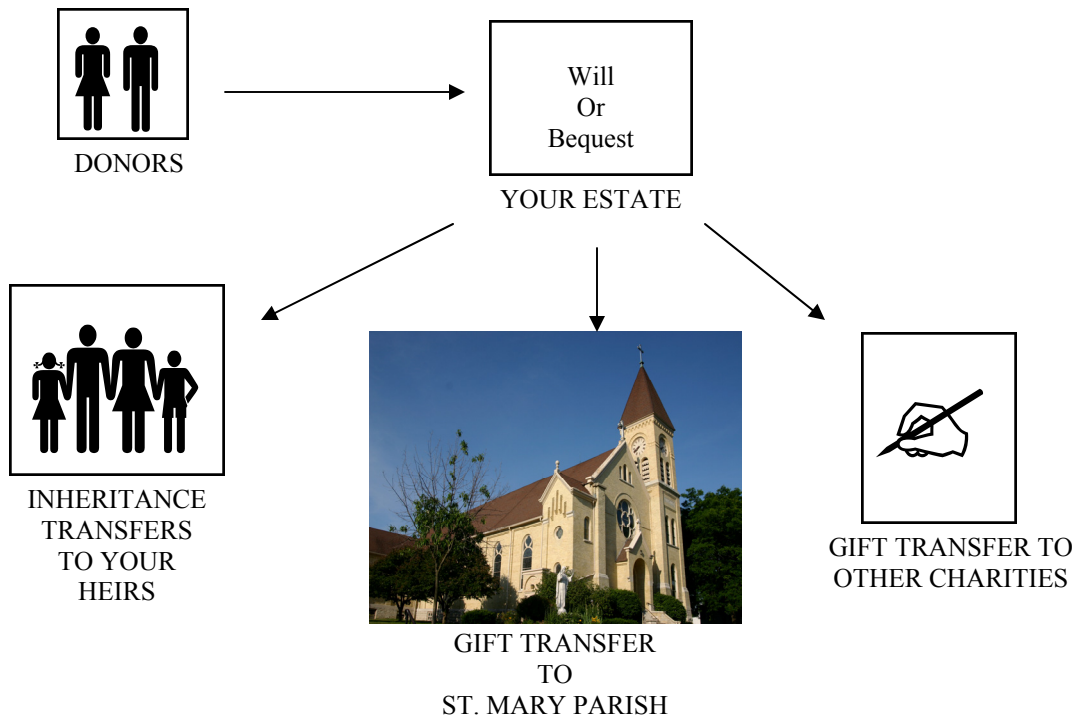


# WILLS AND BEQUESTS



## Here's What Happens

By completing a Will or setting up a trust, you are providing future gifts

- for your heirs
- for your parish
- for other charities of your choice.

You can leave a gift for a percentage of your estate, a specific amount or a residuary amount.

## How It May Benefit You

If you are concerned with having enough income in the future but still want to make a significant gift, a bequest is a good option because:

Your assets remain in your control during your lifetime.

You can change or modify your Will at any time. Consult with your attorney to make changes.

Leaving an asset to your parish in your Will removes that asset from your estate saving possible estate taxes.

You will have the satisfaction of knowing that your bequest will provide for future generations of St. Mary Parish as you intended.
